Progress report- Every student is required to make a fortnightly progress report regarding the consultation and progress made in each of the components of this paper. Every Thursday during 7 to 9pm the students should meet the supervising teacher for consultation and progress/progress report. Students may meet on Friday or Saturday too. If for any reason you want to meet the teacher on Monday/Tuesday/ Wednesday, you are always welcome.

Class Room Teaching (20 Marks)

Requirement-2 actual class room teaching sessions of 30 minutes each.

Each class room teaching should be accompanied with submission of

1. a brief writeup on the topic or PPT on the topic and
2. a geotagged photo of the teaching exercise.

CAL students will teach on a self-chosen topic in FY LL B Constitutional Law I class or SY LL B Constitutional law II class. BL students will teach Contract Law II or Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code. However, if any student desires to teach any other topic from any other law in the ongoing LL B subjects, the supervising teacher will guide and arrange with permission of the Principal. The supervising teacher will arrange upon your request confirming the topic for class-room teaching. The topic proposed and confirmed should get reflected in the progress report.

Evaluation: Students should use the white board while teaching. You are free to use charts and such other teaching aids that you choose to use. While marking, the supervising teacher should consider the topic coverage, effective use of time, correctness and updated content, confidence, teaching method(s) explored, answer to questions and flow. **Attire-**the students should be in proper black and white formals.

First class room teaching should be over in January and the second in February.



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Seminar (20 marks)

- ✓ It is compulsory to attend the 28th Feb. Seminar organized by the college on Regulatory Landscape. The seminar brochure is shared several times in the *whatsapp* group. On 9th Jan it will be shared again. All semester III students are auto-registered for the seminar on 28th Feb from 10.30 to 5.30pm
- ✓ Give abstract paper for the seminar by 31st Jan
- ✓ Give full paper by March 20th (1500 to 4000 words)

Supervising teacher will guide as to the abstract format and full paper. Consult the brochure shared with you.

Practical Components (50 marks)

Requirement: Any one of the following-

(g) Case comment (40 pages)

Choose any one SC judgement or a foreign judgement concerning any of the two papers of your specialization for this semester for the case comment. Stating the name of the case, citation and bench details bring out the facts, issues, arguments and judgement. Conclude with your critical comment.

OR

(a) Loopholes / Lacunae in existing laws & reports (40 pages)

Firstly, give a proposal of 2 pages stating briefly the law chosen and & the reason for sensing loopholes. Secondly, the 40 pages report on the law, lacuna and your suggestion.

OR

(c) Comparative study and utility in India (40 pages)

Choose a topic from any of your specialization paper and compare it with any other country's law on the topic. Bring out the utility of the study in India by recommending some reforms.

Examples- fire insurance law in India and Malaysia; judicial review in India and America

General-Consult your supervising teacher regularly and such consultation should reflect in your progress report. Do not get AI generated content. Give acknowledgement to authors by proper references. Plagiarism should not be more than 15%. Along with the practical component submission, student should attach a plagiarism report, mandatorily; without such report the submission will not be received.

While accepting the practical component submission, the supervising teachers will ask questions to check the credibility of the work.
